CHAPTER 3- STANDARD SPEED CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS

3.3 GENERAL OBLIGATIONS

3.3.6. Use of a Co-Driver

- 3.3.6.1.** The use of a Co-Driver is optional and must follow the provision in article 3.2.3.3. and 3.2.6.1.
Driver & Co-Driver can not change places during the event and can participate only in one competition car. If a Co-Driver is stated in the entry form then he must be present in all runs, except if the Stewards of the meeting permit otherwise.

3.5 SCRUTINEERING - PENALTIES

2.5.1. Scrutineering before the start and during the event

2.5.1.8.1. Helmets

All drivers and co-drivers competing in rally special stages must wear crash helmets which meet one of the FIA standards listed in technical list N° 25 of Appendix J and follow the limitations of FIA Appendix L, Chapter III – Driver's Equipment 1.1 to 1.4.

2.5.1.8.2. Flame-resistant clothing

All drivers and co-drivers competing in rally special stages must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard and follow the limitations of FIA Appendix L, Chapter III – Driver's Equipment par. 2.

3.5.1.8.3. HANS System (Head And Neck Support)

The use of any device intended to protect the head or neck and attached to the helmet is not compulsory, but is recommended for increased safety. If used, it must follow the limitations of Appendix L, Chapter III – Driver's Equipment 3.1. and 3.2.

3.5 SCRUTINEERING - PENALTIES

2.5.1. Scrutineering before the start and during the event

3.5.1.3.1. Helmets

All drivers or co-drivers competing in speed events must wear crash helmets which meet one of the FIA standards listed in technical list N° 25 of Appendix J and follow the limitations of FIA Appendix L, Chapter III – Driver's Equipment 1.1 to 1.4.

3.5.1.3.2. Flame-resistant clothing

All drivers or co-drivers competing in speed events must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard and follow the limitations of FIA Appendix L, Chapter III – Driver's Equipment par. 2.
Long underwear and balaclavas are optional for speed events.

3.5.1.3.3. HANS System (Head And Neck Support)

The use of any device intended to protect the head or neck and attached to the helmet is not compulsory, but is recommended for increased safety. If used, it must follow the limitations of Appendix L, Chapter III – Driver's Equipment 3.1. and 3.2.
