

CHAPTER 2 – GENERAL REGULATIONS

- 2.1.** All national events, held in Cyprus may only be organised by a Member-Club of the C.M.F. and with the approval of the Sporting Council of the C.M.F..
- 2.2.** Events counting towards any of the Championships listed in Chapter 1 of IV. CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS are termed Championship events.
- 2.3.** Championship events will be conducted under the CMF's National Sporting Code, the respective Championship Regulations and any Regulations issued by the C.M.F. as well as any Supplementary Regulations issued by the Organisers and approved by the Sporting Council.
- 2.4.** The C.M.F. will declare at the end of the year the Champions, Cup and Trophy Winners for the year. All National Championships expire at the 31st December each year.
- 2.5.** All competitors participating in any of the Championship events must be holders of a valid National Competition Licence issued by the C.M.F.
- 2.6.** The tables of the final Championships', Cups' and Trophies' results will include all those drivers who have received even 1 point.
- 2.7.** Ties in a Championship:
In case of a tie in the final Championship, Cup or Trophy tables, the one who has the most 1st overall wins will be predominant. If still a tie exists, the one with most 2nd overall results, then 3rd overall etc. will be the winner.
If a tie still exists, then the winner of the category in the 1st (or 2nd etc) event of the season will be predominant.
- 2.8.** In the making up of the final table for the Championships and Trophies the highest scores (number of points) from the following number of events will count:

If 7 or more events are organised, all but 2 will count
If 5 or 6 events are organised, all but 1 will count
If 4 events are organised, all will count
If less than 4 events are organised, the Championship will not be awarded.
- If a Cypriot Driver or Co-Driver, holder of a valid CMF Competition license is classified in one or more overseas events, he may count the points of one such result in substitution of the points of a locally held Championship Event, provided that:
- 2.8.1** Such overseas event is run during the relevant calendar year and the start of such an event is before the last locally held event start, and
- 2.8.2** The total number of results counting in the final table of the Championship is not increased, i.e. if 7 are actually run in the Championship, only 5 results will count including possibly the one overseas event and
- 2.8.3** has participated in at least 50% of the national events counting towards the same Championship.
- The leading competitors of the final tables of the Championships will be the Champions of the respective Championships of the year.
- 2.9.** In the National Championships, Cups and Trophies, unless otherwise stated, only holders of competition licences issued by the C.M.F. will score points.
- 2.10.** The points to be scored towards the Championships from each event will be the following multiplied by the coefficient of the event wherever a coefficient is applicable:

2.10.1 In all the **Rally Championships**, the points which a Driver or Co-driver will receive in each proclaimed category from each event will be the following multiplied by the coefficient of the event:

1 st Overall	25 points	6 th Overall	8 points
2 nd Overall	18 points	7 th Overall	6 points
3 rd Overall	15 points	8 th Overall	4 points
4 th Overall	12 points	9 th Overall	2 points
5 th Overall	10 points	10 th Overall	1 point

Group S cars will receive points only for the Group S championships and their final classification in an event will not effect the classification of the other groups.

2.10.2 For the **Rally Championship for Makes**, the points will be the sum of points obtained from the overall results and from the Group results, as follows:

For overall position:

1 st Overall	10 points
2 nd Overall	8 points
3 rd Overall	6 points
4 th Overall	5 points
5 th Overall	4 points
6 th Overall	3 points
7 th Overall	2 points
8 th Overall	1 point

For Group position:

1 st in Group	3 points
2 nd in Group	2 points
3 rd in Group	1 point

The points for any one competing car will be the sum of the overall and group points. After the above sum is found each make of car is awarded only the highest sum awarded to one car of that particular make.

For example, if a car, make X is 1st overall, and 1st Group A, it is awarded 13 points. If a car make Y is 2nd overall, and 2nd Group A, it is awarded 8 points. If another car make X is 3rd overall, and 1st Group N, its points would have been 7, but as make X already has more than 7 points from another car, it cannot increase its score. If a car make Z is 4th overall and 2nd Group N, it will receive 5 points.

2.10.3. For all the **Speed, Hill & Time Attack Climb Championships**, the points that will be received in each proclaimed category from each event are the following:

1 st Overall	10 points	5 th Overall	4 points
2 nd Overall	8 points	6 th Overall	3 points
3 rd Overall	6 points	7 th Overall	2 points
4 th Overall	5 points	8 th Overall	1 point

2.10.4. For the **Speed Championship for Makes**, the points will be the sum of points obtained from the overall results and from the group result, as follows:

For overall position:

1 st Overall	10 points
2 nd Overall	8 points
3 rd Overall	6 points
4 th Overall	5 points
5 th Overall	4 points
6 th Overall	3 points
7 th Overall	2 points
8 th Overall	1 point

For Group position:

1 st in Group	3 points
2 nd in Group	2 points
3 rd in Group	1 point

However only cars of Groups of Series I will be eligible, although in the calculation of their points resulting from their Overall position, Series II cars will also be counted. In any case only the first 6 in the overall results receive any points.

The points for any one competing car will be the sum of the overall and group points. After the above sum is found each make of car is awarded only the highest sum awarded to one car of that particular make.

2.10.5. For the **Group N Rally Championship for Makes**, for the **Group N Speed Championship for Makes**, for the **2WD Rally Championship for Makes** and for the **Group T Rally & Speed Championship for Makes**, the points to be awarded will be as follows:

1 st Overall	10 points	5 th Overall	4 points
2 nd Overall	8 points	6 th Overall	3 points
3 rd Overall	6 points	7 th Overall	2 points
4 th Overall	5 points	8 th Overall	1 point

Each make of car can receive points from only one car in each event.

2.10.6. For a Make Championship to take place there must be more than two makes interested and they must inform in writing the Federation one month before the Championship starts.

2.11. In the case of international events run in Cyprus only the Cypriot drivers and co-drivers are taken into consideration. All foreign crews are excluded from the list of the points awarded. In the Trophies for Makes only cars driven by Cypriot Drivers are taken into consideration and points are awarded to the makes classified.

2.12. In case of events run outside of Cyprus and counting in any of the National Championships, the final position of all Cypriot Drivers classified will be taken into consideration in calculating the points to be awarded. However, only holders of C.M.F. Competition licences will be awarded points in the proclaimed Championships for Drivers and Co-Drivers for the current year.

In the Championships for Makes, points will be awarded only if the Driver is a Cypriot National and a C.M.F. licence holder and the car used was also used by any Cypriot Driver to participate in at least one local event in the C.M.F. National Championships during the same year.

If in such foreign event, one or more cars of the same make are classified in front of the Cypriot Driver, all cars are counted in establishing the position of the Cypriot Driver and his car. For example if a Cypriot Driver is classified second overall in a car of the same Make and Group as the overall winner, that Make will receive the points awarded to the second overall and second in Group in the Championship for Makes.

2.13. Coefficients of Events

2.13.1. All rallies held in Cyprus counting for the National Rally Championships will have a coefficient of 1.00, 1.25 & 1.50 as specified in the Sporting Calendar.

2.13.2. All international events will have a coefficient of 2.

2.13.3. Speed, 4X4 Trials and Drag Race Events

All events held in Cyprus counting for the respective Championships will have a coefficient of 1.00.

2.13.4. 4X4 Baja Events

All events held in Cyprus Country for the 4X4 Off-Road Championship will have a coefficient 2.00 or as otherwise stated at the beginning of the year by official written notification of the C.M.F.
