

V. RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP

CHAPTER 1 – COMMON ORGANISING CONDITIONS

- 1.1** A National event in the Rally Championship shall include a common course of not more than 400 km including at least 10 Special Stages of total length of not less than 120 km.
- 1.2** The Route of a National event in the Rally Championship will be secret until 15 days prior to the Starting Time of the rally.
- 1.3** The Road Book must be in conformity with the standard road book.
- 1.4** The C.M.F. and its Sporting Council bear no responsibility whatsoever for loss or damage or injury which might arise out of any accident during any event.
- 1.5** The Supplementary Regulations of each national event in the Rally Championship should include the minimum following information:
- 1.5.1** Name, address, telephone, etc of the Organisers.
- 1.5.2** Programme, stating addresses and locations (if applicable) as well as dates and times of the following (and of any other functions):
- Entries Open
 - Issue of Road Book
 - Entries Close (18:00 hours of Friday, of the week before the Start)
 - Reconnaissance (if any)
 - Documentation
 - Scrutineering (Pre-Rally, Final)
 - Start
 - Regrouping(s) (if any)
 - Finish
 - Posting of official provisional results
 - Prize giving
- 1.5.3** Address and Location and times of operation (if applicable) of:
- Rally H.Q.
 - Official Notice Board(s)
 - Press Rooms (if any)
- 1.5.4** Names of Officials including all of the following:
- Observer (Appointed by Motorsport Committee)
 - Stewards (Chairman & 2nd Steward are appointed by Motorsport Committee)
 - Organising Committee (stating who is the chairman)
 - Clerk of the Course (and Deputies and Assistants if any)
 - Secretary
 - The Chief Safety Officer
 - The Chief Marshal
 - The Chief Results
 - The Chief Scrutineer (Appointed by the Motorsport Committee)
 - The Medical Officer
 - The Press & P. R. Officer
 - C.R.O.
- 1.5.5** A clause stating that the event is run in compliance with:

- the National Sporting Code (and its Appendices) of the C.M.F.,
 - the Standard National Rally Championship Regulations (including Addenda-Bulletins) and
 - the Rally's own Supplementary Regulations (including Addenda-Bulletins) as approved by the Sporting Council of the C.M.F.
- 1.5.6** A short description of the event stating in which Championships, Cups and Trophies it counts towards
- 1.5.7** The following facts regarding the Route:
- Total length
 - Number of Special Stages
 - Total length of Special Stages
- 1.5.8** Details of the insurance cover and the insurance company name.
- 1.5.9** Any variations from the Standard Regulations, which must have been specifically approved by the Motorsport Committee of the C.M.F.
- 1.5.10** The C.M.F.'s Sporting Council permit number and date.
- 1.5.11** The emblems of the Organising Club, C.M.F., the C.S.O. (K.O.A) and the Sponsors (if any).
- 1.5.12** The Itinerary
- 1.5.13** Eligible Cars
- 1.5.14** Deadline and other details for sending the entry form
- 1.5.15** Entry Fees and possible optional advertising proposed by the Organisers.
